### Current Priorities:

Our current priorities in the Bridge of Allan area continue to be Anti-Social Behaviour, Road Safety and Community Engagement and Reassurance.

**Main Report:**

Between the 10<sup>th</sup> February and 13<sup>th</sup> March 2022 a total of 5 crimes occurred within the Bridge of Allan area (which also covers University of Stirling). The crimes detailed below are those that are of relevance to the local community.

**ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR**

**VIOLENT CRIME**

**HOUSEBREAKINGS/CRIMES OF DISHONESTY**

Sometime between the 19<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> of February 2022 an attempt was made to break into retail property at New Street, Bridge of Allan where efforts were made to overcome the security. This is an ongoing enquiry at the time of update, PS-20220222-1342 refers.

**ROAD SAFETY AND ROAD TRAFFIC RELATED CRIME**

On the 24<sup>th</sup> of February within the grounds of University of Stirling a vehicle was struck by another vehicle, the driver of which failed to stop or report the accident. This is under investigation at the time of submission, PS-20220224-3558 refers.

On the 10<sup>th</sup> of March 2022 a two vehicle road accident occurred on Airthrey Road near to the university whereby one of the vehicles failed to stop. This is under investigation at the time of the update with a positive line of enquiry to be followed up, PS-20220310-1961 refers.

**MATTERS OF NOTE**

**OFFICIAL**

Between the 10th of February and 13<sup>th</sup> March 2022, there was a total of 96 calls to the Bridge of Allan area. Please note this also covers parts of the Cornton, Causewayhead and Stirling University.

A breakdown of some of these calls is as follows, 8 were concern for person type calls, 2 calls were drugs/substance related, 2 neighbour dispute calls, 2 calls were theft related, 4 were domestic related incidents and 14 were road traffic related calls.

**Community engagement and reassurance:**

Mobile patrols carried out in and around Bridge of Allan Primary School with no issues being identified.

**Activity for forthcoming month:**

1. Carry out a road traffic operation, date and location to be confirmed.
2. Scam Awareness - Engage with vulnerable members of the community, raise awareness in relation to Fraud and offered appropriate crime prevention advice.
